Kelly Stephen is currently the chaplain of Monsignor Paul Dwyer Catholic secondary school. He has worked for 25 years as a secondary school chaplain within the Catholic system. He has worked closely with students who identify as belonging to the 2SLGBTQ plus community. He himself identifies as being a gay man. As a devout practising Catholic he has managed to reconcile his orientation with his faith.

Fr. Bernard Carroll, S.J. He entered the Society of Jesus in 1959 and was ordained in 1971. His Jesuit life has included teaching high school French; Campus Ministry during which time he also taught French language and social studies. He was involved with animating formation ministry with Indigenous people in Northern Ontario and for 10 years was a spiritual director at Loyola House. He was pastor of Holy Rosary parish in Guelph, followed by 5 years as Director of Martyrs Shrine in Midland. In 2016 he returned to Loyola House as a spiritual director and in October 2023 he became the Superior of the Pickering Jesuit Community.
