Fr. Bernard Carroll, S.J. was born and grew up in a bilingual family in Montreal, Quebec. He entered the Society of Jesus in 1959 and was ordained in 1971. His Jesuit life has included teaching high school French; Campus Ministry during which time he also taught French language and social studies. He was Assistant Novice Director and Vocation Director for the Jesuits in English Canada; was involved with animating formation ministry with Indigenous people in Northern Ontario and for 10 years was a spiritual director at Loyola House. He was pastor of Holy Rosary parish in Guelph, followed by 5 years as Director of Martyrs Shrine in Midland. In 2016 he returned to Loyola House as a spiritual director and in October 2023 he became the Superior of the Pickering Jesuit Community. His special pastoral interests are in individual and communal spiritual growth, evolutionary and eco-spirituality, and liturgy.
