Fr. Charles Pottie, SJ (pronounced, "Pâté"), is originally from Nova Scotia with Acadian roots. He entered the Society of Jesus in 1959 and has completed 62 years as a Jesuit. He taught liturgy and sacramental theology from 1980 to 2006 in various universities - in Toronto, Ottawa, Rome, Halifax. He has been giving the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola since 1970 in one form or another, accompanying people in their journey of faith. He had been in the Calgary diocese from September of 2011 to August 2019 and his ministry involved the continuation of his work with Ignatian Spirituality including the Spiritual Exercises, retreats, and spiritual direction and as Jesuit liaison with Christian Life Community – a lay association rooted in the Ignatian vision. He had resided at St. Mary's Cathedral Rectory in Calgary, had similar ministry in the Atlantic region, based in Halifax, NS. with another Jesuit, working with lay partners in promoting Ignatian spirituality. He is now doing pastoral ministry at Manresa Jesuit Centre in Pickering.
